Rules for a safe holiday around cattle

Avoid contact with grazing animals.
Do not feed the animals, maintain a safe distance at all times!

Always keep dogs under control and on a short leash. If it becomes clear that a cow is going to attack: let your dog off the lead immediately!

If a cow approaches you: Stay calm, don't turn your back on the animal and give it a wide berth!

Try not to be loud. Do not startle cattle!

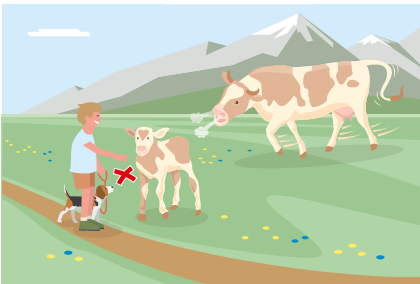
Do not stray from the path!

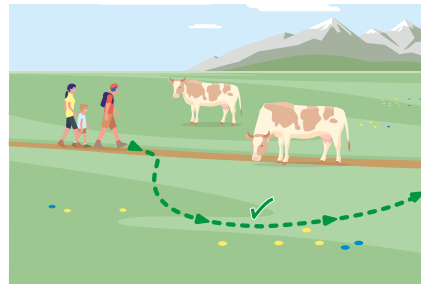
At the first sign of the animals seeming unsettled, remain calm and leave the area quickly!

Mother cows protect their calves. Avoid cows with calves, especially if you have a dog with you!

If cattle block your path give them the widest berth you can!

Respect fences! If there is a gate, please use it and close it afterwards, then cross the meadow swiftly!

Recommendations for a fair treatment of nature

THANK YOU for

- staying out of the forest at dawn, dusk and at night - this allows wildlife to feed in peace.
- staying on marked routes and paths - this way wild animals can get used to recreational athletes and usually do not perceive them as a threat.
- keeping your dog on a leash - otherwise it could endanger wild animals.
- not let your dog use agricultural land as a dog toilet during the growing season.
- not leaving any garbage behind and taking your garbage, including leftovers, back to the valley.
- not entering wildlife resting and feeding zones and avoiding them.
